HAROLD AND THE PURPLE CRAYON SEP 6-10 *New 7 pm time on Fri. & Sat.*

Inside of his book, adventurous Harold (Zachary Levi) can make anything come to life simply by drawing it. After he grows up and draws himself off the book's pages and into the physical world, Harold finds he has a lot to learn about real life—and that his trusty purple crayon may set off more hilarious hijinks than he thought possible.

Rated: PG for mild action and thematic elements. Runtime: 90 min

TRAP SEP 13-17

This horror-thriller movie follows a serial killer evading a police blockade while attending a concert with his daughter. Rated: PG-13 for some violent content and brief strong language. Runtime: 105 min

TWISTERS SEP 19-24

Lydia's life is turned upside down when her rebellious teenage daughter, Astrid, discovers the mysterious model of the town in the attic and the portal to the Afterlife is accidentally opened. It's only a matter of time until someone says Beetlejuice's name three times and the mischievous demon returns to unleash his very own brand of mayhem.
