**PUSS IN BOOTS: THE LAST WISH** – Puss in Boots is back in action. Academy Award nominee Antonio Banderas will again voice the suave feline outlaw, as Puss in Boots discovers that his passion for adventure has taken its toll: He has burned through eight of his nine lives, leaving him with only one life left. Puss sets out on an epic journey to find the mythical Last Wish and restore his nine lives.

A MAN CALLED OTTO - Otto (Tom Hanks) is a grumpy isolated widower with staunch principles, strict routines and a short fuse, who gives everyone in his neighborhood a hard time as he watches over it like a hawk. Just as it seems like he's finally given up on life, an unlikely and reluctant friendship develops with his new neighbors. Little by little, Otto undergoes a subtle transformation... but is he really capable of change? The film will be directed by Marc Forster. Two-time Oscar nominee David Magee is adapting the screenplay from Fredrik Backman's 1# New York Times Bestseller "A Man Called Ove" - with the titular character being renamed to reflect the shift to an American setting. Fredrik Wikström Nicastro, Rita Wilson, Tom Hanks and Gary Goetzman are producing. Marc Forster, Renée Wolfe and David Magee will serve as executive producers. The film stars Tom Hanks, Mariana Treviño, Rachel Keller and Manuel Garcia-Rulfo.

THE FABELMANS - The film, which is loosely based on Spielberg's childhood, stars Michelle Williams, Seth Rogen, Paul Dano and Gabriel LaBelle. Steven Spielberg co-wrote the script alongside Tony Kushner. Spielberg, Kushner and Kristie Macosko Krieger are producing.

THE WHALE - From Darren Aronofsky comes The Whale, the story of a reclusive English teacher living with severe obesity who attempts to reconnect with his estranged teenage daughter for one last chance at redemption. Starring Brendan Fraser and based on the acclaimed play by Samuel D. Hunter.

Fed up with the pressures and demands of her acting career, the famous Myra Marlowe leases a house in the tiny New England hamlet of Beaver Haven and settles down to write her autobiography. She is successful in turning aside the offers pressed on her by her long-time agent, but dealing with her nosy,

omnipresent neighbors is a different matter. In an attempt to shoo them away, and gain some privacy, Myra invents a mad, homicidal sister—who is kept locked in an upstairs room, but who occasionally escapes long enough to scare off uninvited visitors. The ruse works well, at first, but complications result when the local handyman develops an affection for “Sister Sadie” (really Myra in a fright wig) and some of the more officious ladies decide it is their Christian duty to save the poor demented Sadie’s soul. In desperation Myra announces that her imaginary sibling has suddenly gone off to Boston—which brings on the sheriff and the suspicion of murder! Needless to say, all is straightened out in the end, but the uproarious doings will keep audiences laughing right up to the final curtain, and then some.

## **Balcony Row 1 has reopened. (Nov 9, 2022)**

**We have completed phase 1 of a more limited balcony remodel.**

**Row 1 (row J), now has 5 inches more foot and leg room than before, and has been opened up for sale.**

**Row K (row 2 in balcony) now has 2 inches less leg room than it had; which is like the rest of the rows in the balcony.**

**Row L (row 3) is now closed, because it does not have enough leg room, until we finish the next phase of remodeling next year. That phase will lift the remaining rows a little higher and farther apart.**
