The Touchet Valley Ministerial Association will sponsor the film, "A Murder of Innocence" at the Liberty **Thursday, March 14 at 7:00 pm.**

The film dramatizes events which took place in Sequim, Washington in 1970, when a young Christian couple was murdered in their home shortly after Albert and Aimee Anderson arrived as new pastors. Based on Aimee's memoir, "Broken, Yet Triumphant," the movie portrays the trauma of a church congregation, the struggles of the community in dealing with the crime, and the power of faith to endure and overcome.

Aimee Anderson's son and daughter-in-law, Mark and Vonda Anderson, live in Dayton. Vonda is the owner of Snowbird Quilting.
